COLLABORATION:

The better we know each other, the better we work together.

Through communication and networking (in person and electronically) we can all learn more about what we do, helping the nonprofit community work more efficiently. A couple services we provide are our bi-monthly newsletter that goes out to over 900 emails and our monthly meetings - for people to get to know each other and about their nonprofit. This builds both knowledge and trust within our nonprofit community.

EDUCATION:

Throughout the year we provide approximately 20 trainings and other events for its members to learn and grow. These opportunities cover everything from current hot topics, running a nonprofit business and case manager's trainings, all leading to improved services. **Our trainings are heavily discounted for members.** We are here to help you grow!

ADVOCACY:

Spearheaded by our advocacy committee, we organize and educate the membership to ensure there is a voice for nonprofits when needed with our elected officials, and to impact legislation. It is up to us to advocate for our clients!



COLLABORATION:

- The Collaborator: a bi-monthly newsletter that only members can submit articles. It is free for the community and goes out to over 1000 emails.
- In Common: A monthly newsletter that goes out to the general community that helps people know who you are and market for your events.
- Monthly Meetings: members can join our monthly meeting to get to know others in our nonprofit community and keep updated on current events.
- Weekly Radio Show: each week a different member is featured on our KZUM radio show to talk about their services or promote and upcoming event.
- Board Matching Event: an annual collaboration with Center for Civic Engagement, we match students with a member's board. A win win for students and our members!
- Networking Events: We host a few networking events for members each year. Another chance for members to meet/greet each other.

POTENTIAL SAVINGS: We also COLLABORATE with for profit partners using our strength in numbers to leverage discounts on services we all use.

EDUCATION:

Regularly Hosted Trainings

Examples of topics are grant writing, leadership skills, marketing, finances, technology and more. Topics come from members' interest and hot topic issues that arise.

Quarterly Case Manager's Training

Examples of topics are working with interpreters, Suicide Prevention, understanding child trauma, safety net services in Lincoln/Lancaster County.

Youth Thrive

As funding permits. A 2.5 day training, a nationally recognized program for youth workers, helping them improve their work with local youth.

Executive Director Discussion Group

Third Thursday's 'Roundish' Table - a free monthly gathering for Directors of member agencies to unwind and ask for and give advice in a confidential setting.

Board Trainings

A free 1.5 hour training for member boards that help them understand their basic roles and responsibilities.

A service for new executive directors, we can match you with an experienced director to help you get settled into your new job and know that you are not alone - many of us have been there.



ADVOCACY:

Advocacy Committee

This committee helps to inform the membership of legislative activity as well as understand the importance of educating our elected officials. They also look for volunteers for our Speaker's Bureau which stands ready to positively affect legislation when necessary.

Lobbying and Advocacy Education

Cause Collective is also working to help the membership understand the rules of lobbying. Many staff of nonprofit are new to this and we can help them get all that mumbo jumbo faster, making it much easier to take that first leap.

• Monthly Meeting Special Guest

We have also have an elected official attend the monthly meetings, making that first introduction easier for members, so they can be more comfortable to reach out to them when needed. This also helps our elected officials understand the impact nonprofits are making in Lincoln.



ANNUAL DUES

Dues are based on the agency's operational budget and on a sliding fee scale:
